Registration Information**

(NO LIVE TURKEYS WILL BE SHOT - ONLY TARGETS)

**How to Get to the Fort Bliss Rod and Gun
Club, Completing the Registration Process, and Shooting Procedures**

This non-profit fundraiser event will be held at the Fort Bliss Rod and Gun Club Complex located at 3730 Roy Johnson Lane, Northeast Fort Bliss.

The range opens at 0800 the day of the shoot. The Turkey Shoot will begin at 0900. Shooting will be continuous throughout the day until 1500 Sunday 15 Nov 2015. Shooters will check in with registration in order to receive shooting badge and direction to their chosen competition.

There will be no daily admission fee for shooters and a \$5 admission fee for spectators over the age of 6. Age 6 and under are free. Payment can be in cash or by credit card on site.

As you arrive at the complex, Event Staff Volunteers will guide you to the parking and registration. You will have a couple of forms to fill out and sign, and then you will be able to take your shotguns/firearms to the Shooter Assembly Area for assignment to a shooting line.

Shooting will take place all day until 1430. Take your time, relax and enjoy the fun of being on the range!

Registration fee will be \$5 per shotgun shell per event. You may shoot in as many events as you would like to. You will be limited to one (1) turkey per event but will have an opportunity to win other prizes. No personal ammunition will be allowed in the competition.

Free Lunches- while sponsors supplies last- for all registered shooters and spectators. Lunch will be provided starting at 1100.

For an additional fee, any other range facilities (apart from the Turkey Shoot) also can be utilized with personal firearms (If available). A great bargain!

IMPORTANT: Shooters must wear hearing and eye protection to move up to the firing line. Bring your own; only limited quantities will be available for sale at the range. Sunglasses and prescription lenses are OK for eye protection.

SHOOTING VENUES

**Bring your Personal Conforming Shotgun;
Limited "Loaner" Event Firearms will be Available**

Poker Shoot (\$5 per shell):

- 5 shooters per event
- Each shooter will choose an event target consisting of 10 playing cards hidden behind a black cover
- Each shooter will have one shot at the target. Placed at 25 yds. away
- Winner is the person with the best poker hand. Poker hand is determined by the cards with a hole from the shot
- Winner receives a turkey or ham coupon for redemption

Closest to the Center Line (\$5 per shell)

- 5 shooters per event
- Each shooter will choose a pre-printed target with a BIG X
- Each shooter will have one shot at the target. Placed at 25 yds. away
- Winner will be the one who is closest to the middle of the X
- Winner receives a turkey or ham coupon for redemption

Quail Walk (\$10 per event)

- 6 shooters per event
- Each shooter will start at the 27 yard line walking to the 16 yard line
- Somewhere between 27 and 16 yard line the clay target will be released
- Shooter must hit the clay target to continue in the event
- Shooters will continue the event until only one (1) shooter is left as the winner.
- Winner receives a turkey or ham coupon for redemption

Anne Oakley Shoot (\$15 per event)

- 6 shooters per event
- Shooters will draw a number 1-6
- Shooters will line up based on their number
- First shooter will call for the bird and fire
- Second shooter will be able to fire at the bird if the first misses or feels they can hit any part left from the first shooter's shot.
- This continues until the bird hits the ground or is completely destroyed
- If the second shooter, and subsequent shooters hit any piece of the bird the shooter in front of them is eliminated
- If the first shoot destroys the whole target then the second shooter calls the bird
- Same process happens until only one (1) shooter is left standing

- Winner receives a turkey or ham coupon for redemption

These events will be held at the same time throughout the day so shooters can participate in various events.

FORT BLISS COMMAND TEAM SHOOTOUT

The day will end with the first Fort Bliss Command Team Shootout! Commanders and Command Sergeants Majors will compete for the title of best shot Command Team.

Each Command team will shoot in the Anne Oakley format. The first group will be Command Sergeants Majors. We will go one time through and if a CSM is eliminated then their Command Team is eliminated. Next will be the remaining Commanders shooting. Same process will be followed until one Command Team remains and will be crowned the Fort Bliss Shootout Champion.

We encourage everyone to come out and support their command team. Feel free to place a donation on your favorite command team. A prize will be awarded to anyone who guesses the number rounds used by the winning command team.

Turkey Shoot rules may be modified prior to or during the event to accommodate pre-event planning feedback and potentially changing conditions discovered at the range.

THE FIRST AND MOST IMPORTANT RULE, WHICH WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED, IS *SAFETY*.
